PART STUDY ABROAD, PART INTERNSHIP-this hybrid summer program provides opportunities to explore and participate in contemporary art and culture in South Africa.

STUDY Through site visits, conversations with arts professionals and museum staff, art-making, and reflection activities, students consider the social, racial, economic, and political factors that impact contemporary art and the institutions charged with preserving and presenting culture. Students examine how museum education, conservation, and curatorial practices contribute to a multicultural society.

INTERN Participants spend the final four weeks of the program working in a Cape Town museum in conservation, education, or curatorial departments. Interning under the direction of accomplished professionals, students gain invaluable real-life museum experience.
