



FLAS Fellowships

Foreign Language and Area Studies (FLAS) Fellowships for MSU graduate and undergraduate students are available through the African Studies Center, provided by a grant from the U.S. Department of Education.

FLAS Fellowships award academic year undergraduate students with \$10,000 toward tuition and fees and a stipend of \$5,000. Academic year graduate students receive \$18,000 toward tuition and fees and \$20,000 in stipends. Summer FLAS recipients receive \$5,000 in tuition and a \$2,500 stipend.

We invite applications for:

- Intensive African Language Study, Summer 2023
- Academic Year African Language Study, 2023-2024

To be eligible,

students must be U.S. citizens or permanent residents.

Undergraduate students must be studying the target language at the **intermediate** or advanced level.

The academic year fellowship requires that students take one language and one area studies course for a letter grade each term during the award period. Summer fellowships are for intensive language study only.
