

The African Postdoctoral Training Initiative (APTI) is currently soliciting applications for a second cohort of fellows, with applications due December 1, 2019. APTI is supported by the African Academy of Sciences (AAS), the U.S. National Institutes of Health (NIH), and the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation to promote the training of early-career African scientists in the field of biomedical research.

FLAS Scholarship

Fellowships for graduate and undergraduate studies in African languages and area studies are available through the African Studies Center, provided by a grant from the U.S. Department of Education. They are designed for American (or permanent resident) students who plan to utilize a modern foreign language in their future careers.

FLAS Fellowships provide academic year undergraduates with \$10,000 towards tuition and fees, and a stipend of \$5,000. For graduate students, FLAS Fellowships provide \$18,000 toward tuition and fees for the academic year, and \$15,000 in stipends. Summer FLAS recipients receive \$5,000 in tuition and a \$2,000 stipend.
